



## You May Qualify for Home Modifications Including a Ramp!

**The Center for Independent Living Options (CILO)**, through a grant from Ohio Statewide Independent Living Council (OSILC) and in partnership with People Working Cooperatively (PWC), is providing a home ramp and/or handrails, grab bars, or other home modifications to assist people with paralysis including stroke, spinal cord injury, MS, cerebral palsy, or any central nervous system injury or disorder resulting in difficulty or inability to move the upper or lower extremities.

### ☀ In Order to Be Eligible, You Should:

- Meet the definition above for paralysis;
- Currently reside in or wish to return to your private residential home;
- Otherwise be unable to access resources to install modifications for an accessible home; and
- Have a need for modifications that will allow you to safely maneuver within your home and/or exit the home in case of an emergency.
- Reside in Adams, Brown, Butler, Clermont, Clinton, Hamilton, Highland or Warren County.
