Re:	Prior Authorization in MSS to Go Live on December 10, 2011

The Division of Medicaid Development and Administration (MDA) is proud to announce the release of the on-line Manage PA process within the Medicaid Services System (MSS). The new MSS/Manage PA process is designed to provide a more effective and efficient process for county boards to use when submitting prior authorization requests (PARs). One key feature of MSS/Manage PA is that it allows users to check the status of PARs in real time throughout the process.

The new MSS/Manage PA process is projected to be available on **December 10, 2011**. Please note that the existing PA mailbox, <u>prior-authorization@list.dodd.ohio.gov</u>, will be inactivated on that same date.

Note: On or after 12/10/2011, supporting documentation must be either emailed or faxed to DODD.

It is important to note that in order to submit a PAR through MSS/Manage PA, the individual must be transitioned to the MSS.
