Dennis Grant – Executive Director, United Rehabilitation Services

Dennis Grant, Chief Executive officer of United Rehabilitation Services of Greater Dayton, (URS) has worked with children and adults with disabilities and their families since 1976 and has been with URS over 24 years. Since joining URS, they have dramatically expanded the scope of services offered and the number of clients and families served. This included a \$7m capital campaign completed in 2016 which more than doubled their capacity. URS offers a broad continuum of care for those with disabilities at all ages and stages of life from six weeks to advanced seniors.

Under Dennis' leadership, their Combined Administrative and Fundraising costs have dropped from a high of over 32% in 2001 to below 10% since 2012.

Dennis has served:

- Five Terms on the Board of Directors of the Ohio Provider Resource Association (OPRA) representing hundreds of organizations across Ohio serving individuals with intellectual and developmental disabilities.
- Dayton Brain Health Collective Advisory Board 2023 - 2024
- Wright State University, Integrated Health Services Advisory Committee 2024 - 2025
- Three terms on the Dayton Area Chamber of Commerce Board of Directors ending in 2022.
- Four terms on the Board of Directors of the United Way of Greater Dayton Area ending in September 2017.
- Five terms as President of the Alliance of Executives, which represented Dayton area social service agencies through 2018.
- Secretary of the United Rehabilitation Services Foundation since 2007.

He is a Licensed Professional Counselor in the State of Ohio and holds an MA in Rehabilitation Counseling and a BS in Special Education both from the University of Cincinnati.
