5123-9-30 - On-Site/On-Call Proposed rule language changes – For Discussion

(B) Definitions

(19) "On-site/on-call" means a rate paid when no need for supervision or supports is anticipated for a minimum continuous period of no less than five hours, and a provider must be on-site and available to provide homemaker/personal care if an unanticipated need arises but is not required to remain awake.

(F) Payment standards

(11) The team shall assess, utilizing the assessment tool included in appendix C of this rule, and document in the individual service plan when on-site/on-call may be appropriate.

(c)A provider shall be paid the routine homemaker/personal care rate instead of the on-site/on-call rate when:

(i) An individual's needs do not allow for an uninterrupted period of at least five consecutive hours with no supervision or support.

(ii) An individual's needs allow for an uninterrupted period of at least five consecutive hours with no supervision or support, but the individual receives supervision or supports at another period during the night. In these instances, the provider shall document the date and beginning and ending times during which supervision or supports were provided to the individual.
