<u>HPC Wage Increase</u>: Earlier this week, Pete sent out a document OPRA helped to prepare in partnership with other stakeholder groups and associations regarding the rate increase for HPC that went into effect on 1/1/20. The letter is intended to explain the rate increase, timelines and the next steps. We hope this is a resource that will be helpful as you discuss the rate increase with your team and the people you serve. The document is attached to the email with this newsletter. <u>Transportation/NMT:</u> The revised rules for Non-medical and HPC transportation have been approved and are set to take effect on Feb 1, 2020. DODD will hold a webinar (link in 'Upcoming Events') next Thursday to explain/train on the changes. OPRA will also be developing training materials for our members to supplement the material provided by DODD. Please contact Scott at smarks@opra.org with any questions.

<u>OOD Provider Qualification</u>: OOD has updated their policy regarding provider qualifications, specifically for those that serve people eligible for developmental disability services. Under the new policy, if a provider is accredited in both 'Individual Employment Supports' and 'Career Planning' for at least 1 year, then they are considered a qualified provider, removing the need to apply for a waiver of CARF to provide Employment First and Supported Employment Services. <u>Overtime Rule:</u> As mentioned on the call today, the new rules regarding overtime went into effect on 1/1/20. Per DOL "The final rule updates the earnings thresholds necessary to exempt executive, administrative and professional employees from the Fair Labor Standards Act's (FLSA) minimum wage and overtime pay requirements, and allows employers to count a portion of certain bonuses/commissions towards meeting the salary level.
