S.3369 - Recognizing the Role of Direct Support Professionals Act

This week saw the introduction of a bi-partisan bill aimed at revising the standard occupational classification (SOC) to include a new code for Direct Support Professionals (DSP), specifically for disability-service professionals. This bill, if enacted, would potentially help establish necessary data to help communicate the workforce crisis. The text of the bill can be read <u>here</u>. Ohio Medicaid Integrated Settings Reviews:

On Wednesday, ODM conducted their first 'pilot' review, evaluating Ohio's progress towards 'integrated settings'. The review, held at Arc Industries, was led by ODM staff as well as compliance staff from DODD. The review , lasted a total of about 2 hours, including a presentation by ARC staff on their future plans, data analytics, and 'day to day activities', followed by an agency tour and several questions from ODM staff. <u>BEST Survey:</u> As part of the transition to Basic Employment Skills Training, DODD, along with BEST Communication Sub-Committee developed a stakeholder survey to help identify needed areas for the service's implementation. Per DODD "In March 2020, DODD is conducting a survey to help communicate these updates and develop resources about the transition from the Vocational Habilitation service to the new Basic Employment Skills Training service in December 2020."
