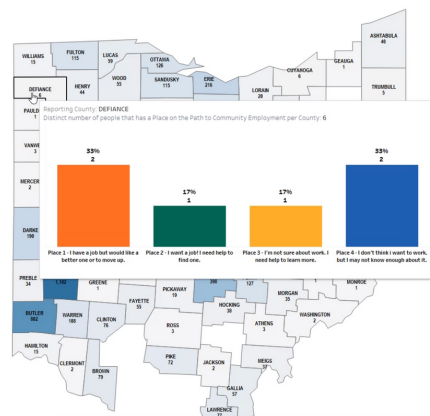
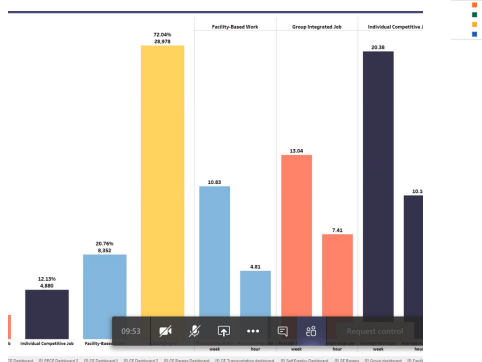
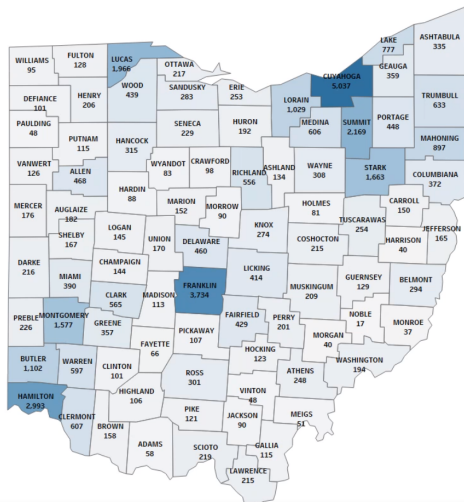

Additional Updates From The OPRA Team and System Partners

Unemployment Insurance: ODJFS recently released an FAQ with important information for agencies who are reimbursing employers for unemployment insurance. Provisions in the CARES Act allowed for a 50% credit for reimbursing employers, and this FAQ outlines the process/schedule to receive those credits starting next month. We know this has been a major issue for many members, and we are glad to see some relief as we continue to push for further relief and solutions. OTS Demonstrations: DODD has held two meetings over the past weeks to demonstrate the reporting capabilities for the Outcome Tracking System (OTS). This system is designed to collect data from providers and county boards as to the outcomes achieved in adult and employment services and provide both qualitative and quantitative data on Ohio's progress towards community employment and integration outcomes. The screenshots below are only examples of the system's reporting capabilities through its clickable Tableau map interface and **do not reflect real data.** The actual data will be available and published by DODD later this summer.
