Appendix K: The application for both regulatory and fiscal relief through appendix K has been split into 2 separate processes in order to expedite the requests to CMS. The state of Ohio recently applied with CMS to renew all of the regulatory relief provided through appendix K, including the changes that make STEP services possible. Following CMS approval of that renewal, Ohio will then submit the application for the approximately 2-week payments we have discussed over the last few weeks. Regulatory relief through appendix K will expire 6 months after the national emergency, which ensures these rule relaxations will be in place through at least October 20, 2021. We will let members know as each application is approved by CMS.

Payroll Protection Program 2: Applications for first and second draw PPP loans started being accepted this week by some financial institutions. The US Treasury recently announced that the application for small lenders begins today and for the general public next Tuesday. The SBA recently updated their website for new and returning PPP borrowers. There is still no guidance about how certain funds received during the pandemic, including PRF, CRF, BWC or Appendix K payments impact an agency's eligibility. We are seeking clarification and hoping for additional guidance from the treasury and/or SBA.

Blueprint Workgroup: The work-group developing recommendations for adult and vocational services has been on hold since late fall. Earlier this week, the group's facilitator reached out to workgroup members to take preliminary steps to re-engage and continue the work put on hold in the fall. DODD is requesting feedback on the several proposals developed, prior to the workgroup meeting again. We will continue to review the proposals and gather member feedback in our day array committees and smaller focus groups. <u>Provider Relief Fund:</u> The reporting period for Provider Relief Funds opened today. If you received money through the program, you should have received an email that included information on how to register to use the reporting portal. The portal is currently only open for registration, not reporting on use of funds. <u>You can find the portal here</u>. HHS has also released <u>important new guidance</u> that supersedes previous guidance.

Vaccine Resource Video: Earlier this week, DODD held a webinar featuring Medical Director, Dr. Laura Sorg aimed at addressing "Myths and Facts About the COVID Vaccine. In addition to addressing specific myths, the webinar goes into some detail about the vaccine's development, and includes fact sheets, timelines for vaccine distribution.
