In 1922, the three-generation legacy of the world famous Dye Golf Course began in Urbana, Ohio when "Pink" Dye, father of the world famous designer Pete Dye, built a nine hole golf course in Champaign County. In 1993, Pete's son, P.B.Dye, finished the job by adding a second nine holes. The Urbana Country Club is home to one of the finest and most beautiful rolling hill, 18 hole golf courses in the state of Ohio.

The Urbana Country Club requires the use of "soft spikes" as well as proper golf attire. Players needing soft spikes installed on their shoes should arrive before 8:30am. The spike fee is \$8.00/pair.
