<u>Advocacy Army:</u> Thank you to everyone who joined us for our advocacy army webinar and who have already signed up. There is still plenty of room if you want to join us! Rules for Review: Earlier this week we were informed that the rules for HCBS Waiver services and Licensed Residential Facilities were up for comment and review. We will of course be thoroughly reviewing these rules and the proposed changes and will be providing comment back to the department. We of course encourage anyone with comments to please send them our way. These are two very big and important rules and we want to make sure that we are representing our members interests with both of them. Comments for the Licensed Residential Facilities rule is due by February 28th and the HCBS Waiver comment is due by March 1st.

<u>HB 466:</u> This week saw proponent testimony on a bill that may be of interest to members. HB 466 which is sponsored by Rep Jay Edwards, has its first hearing in the Ohio House Labor and Commerce Committee. The bill would attempt create licensing requirements and regulations on temporary health care staffing agencies. For OPRA members who use these kinds of agencies for positions like nursing, you may want to take a look at this bill. <u>You can read the bill language and summary by clicking here.</u> Please reach out to <u>Christine</u> with any questions.

Mandate: The CMS IFR went into effect here in Ohio with the Phase 1 implementation date of this past Monday. Phase 2 implementation is March 15th. We did hear from two of our members this week that did have ODH surveys. And, in one of these cases, the surveyors and their supervisor stated that they were citing the ICF due to not having off site, contracted day facilities in their vaccination policy, which contradicted everything that CMS said a couple weeks ago regarding contracted facilities off site. We did put in a couple calls to our contacts at ODH about this and the issue appears to be resolved with ODH clarifying to these surveyors that off-site contracted facilities were NOT included in the IFR. So we do appreciate that ODH helped to clarify. So if you do happen to have ODH coming in to survey and you run into issues regarding this mandate – or any other issue – please be sure to reach out to Rachel so that we can get on the phone attempt to rectify with ODH.

We know many of you network with other non-OPRA member providers in their communities and regions.
