

Do's and Don'ts on the Plaza at the Columbus Buddy Walk®

We gladly welcome the following:

- 1. Engaging the audience with some type of family friendly activity at your table
 - For example: a craft project, tattoos, stickers, game
- 2. Bring a pop up tent
 - You will be provided with tables and chairs, however you should bring your own tent for weather coverage
- 3. Bring informational materials on your organization
 - We estimate over 5,000 people will be in attendance

We do NOT permit the following:

- 1. Fundraising for your organization of any kind, <u>only</u> fundraising for the Columbus Buddy Walk® is allowed.
- 2. No religious or political information is to be distributed.
- 3. Nothing can be sold at your booth, and/or no exchange of money with audience.
- 4. Give-a-ways should be available for all people (5,000) and limited to small promotional items or candy.

If any of these outlined "not permitted" activities occur you will be asked to leave the Plaza immediately and will not be asked back to any future Columbus Buddy Walk®.
