<u>Blueprint:</u> The Rule & Waiver Implementation sub-committee of the Blueprint workgroup met again this week to continue the work around redesigning the rate and service framework for non-work adult services, The Milliman consulting team led a discussion around the resources and staffing needed for ADS services delivered in the community, facility or hybrid models. The group also began to explore different outcome or value-based reimbursement models and how aspects of those models could potentially be introduced into the rate model. 
<u>Leadership Training:</u> We want to thank Scott Warrick and Jamie Steele for another session of 'Take Back Your Culture Now' leadership training this week. <u>CMS QSOs:</u> CMS has recently put out some new guidance regarding the vaccine mandate. <u>QSO-22-17-ALL</u> discusses the frequency of vaccination mandate survey compliance. Previously, vaccine compliance review was required with every survey. In the new QSO, CMS is now stating that ODH is not required to survey for vaccine compliance with every survey. An example would be a complaint survey that has nothing to do with vaccine compliance. In that instance, the surveyor does not need to survey vaccine mandate compliance. CMS is still requiring the vaccination mandate be surveyed for initial and recertification surveys. <u>Provider Relief Fund:</u> "Providers who received one or more Provider Relief Fund (PRF) payments exceeding \$10,000, in the aggregate, from January 1, 2021 to June 30, 2021 must report on their use of funds during Reporting Period 3 (RP3). The PRF Reporting Portal for RP3 is now open and will remain open through September 30, 2022. HRSA will host technical assistance webcasts for new and returning reporting entities. Providers must register to attend:

- New Reporting Entities: PRF Reporting Requirements Intro: July 12, 2022, 3:00-4:00 PM ET.
- Information for Returning Reporters: July 13, 2022, 3:00 4:00 ET."

HIPAA On-Demand: OPRA is introducing on-demand privacy and security training for staff! Training is a critical defense against intrusions that breach privacy and IT systems. Why? Because training provides awareness and vigilance. All it takes is one click on a malicious email or link to open a backdoor into even the most secure databases. In partnership with MyHIPAA Guide, OPRA is now offering an on-demand course for staff that will fulfill privacy and cybersecurity training requirements under the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA). Most importantly, this training will instruct staff on how to recognize suspicious activity and how to respond promptly and effectively. This 40-minute, virtual course includes four modules.
