<u>Retention Program:</u> Following last week's CMS approval of the Appendix K application approving the 6.5% retention payment program, <u>DOD filed this rule</u>. OPRA submitted official comments this week which you can read <u>here</u>. There are still many questions about program rollout, and DODD will be providing training, FAQs, and other resources to ready the field. We at OPRA will hold member trainings and town hall sessions as we get closer to the program's actual implementation.

<u>Federal Legislation:</u> The US Senate finally released the budget reconciliation bill previously referred to Build Back Better and Better Care, Better Jobs Act. The new bill, the Inflation Reduction Act of 2022, unfortunately, does not include the \$150B for home and community-based waiver services discussed in previous negotiations. You can read what is included in the bill <u>here</u>.

<u>OPRA's Salary Survey:</u> Our salary survey vendor sent us a draft report this week. There are some minor revisions that need to be made before distributing the survey. We hope to have the survey distributed to those of you who completed the survey in the very near future. We will be going over some of the high-level results at our August 9th HR Committee Meeting. <u>August Primaries:</u> The primary elections for the General Assembly are this upcoming Tuesday, August 2nd. <u>You can find their 2022 General Assembly Districts here</u>. You can find the candidates running by visiting your local county board of elections website. This primary election will determine who is running in the general election in November, which will directly impact who will be working on the budget next year. We encourage you to research your local races and participate on Tuesday.

<u>ICF Rates:</u> Rates for ICF's were released this week and are uploaded in the Medicaid Information Technology System (MITS). Our partners at Brady Ware are analyzing the rates and preparing a summary on how the rates changed on a statewide level. View the rates <u>here</u>.

<u>IProvider Network Management Module:</u> DODD shared <u>this update</u> on ODM's transition to the new Provider Network Management module and the resulting blackout dates of Provider Services Management. Please make sure you have any pending edits submitted before the listed blackout dates.
