Mid-Term Elections: Thank you to everyone who stayed on for the Post-Midterm Election Recap. As mostly expected, Governor Mike DeWine was reelected with 63% of the vote, meaning we will likely see a stable cabinet and a budget introduced by late February. Other Statewide Offices such as Attorney General, Auditor, Secretary of State, and Treasurer all were won by the incumbents. Although we will likely not know which party will control the US House and Senate, J.D. Vance defeated Rep. Tim Ryan in the race for Senator Portman's seat, following his pending retirement. In the Ohio legislature, both Rep. Thomas West and Senator Tina Maharath lost their reelection bids, growing the Republican supermajority in both Ohio chambers. The next few weeks will be full of additional campaigning for the Ohio Speaker of the House race. The winner of this race will determine what the House will prioritize, who will become Committee chairs, how the House will operate. We will have much more news and updates in the coming weeks on the election and the

lame duck and budget seasons going forward. We also had the opportunity to attend the Impact Ohio Post-General Election Conference on Thursday hosted by the Ohio Chamber of Commerce. Speakers included Lt. Governor Jon Husted and Senator-elect JD Vance. Themes of the conference included lame duck session priorities, the upcoming budget, cooperation between the parties, House and Senate District maps, and dealing with over-regulation





ICF Quality Indicators: This week the department put out a reminder for ICF's that submitted their policies for participation in the Quality Incentive program. The department has stated that random on-site reviews for those already participating in the Quality Incentive program will begin taking place in January 2023. If you are wanting to participate in this program, please be sure to get your policies written and into effect prior to December 31st of this year.

<u>DD Day:</u> The DD Legislative Advocacy Day Planning Committee is currently planning the theme and speakers for next year's event. CMS/ICF QSO: CMS recently released QSO-23-02-ALL. There are several changes within this QSO that ICF's need to be aware of. This QSO consolidates much of the information from previous QSO's including QSO 22-07-ALL Revised, QSO 22-09-ALL Revised, and QSO 22-11-ALL Revised. There are some changes that may offer providers more discretion and flexibility, particularly around what types of precautions a facility can implement for mitigation of transmission.
