Retention Program: The portal to 'opt-in' to the 6.5% Retention program went live this week on Tuesday. We've received several emails about the portal not working properly, or providers being locked out. We believe that most of those issues have been patched/fixed by DODD, but if you are still having issues accessing the portal, please let us know. We have also received several questions from members about different aspects of the program, especially around the 2 different payment options. We are working with our partners at Vorys to develop an FAQ around many of the more complicated/nuanced aspects of the options. <u>Blueprint Proposal:</u> Thank you to everyone who attended yesterday's Day & Employment meeting. We appreciate all of the strong feedback regarding the proposal developed by DODD and Milliman through the Blueprint workgroup. We share the same concerns and frustrations with many aspects of the proposal and will work with our members and committees to develop feedback, alternatives and counter-proposals. <u>Ohio House Leadership:</u> This week marked the start of the 135th General Assembly. On Tuesday, in a surprise vote, the House elected Jason Stephens into the Speaker's role. For more than a month, we anticipated Representative Derek Merrin would claim the gavel after a Republican-only vote showed Rep. Merrin had the votes for the role. However, 22 Republicans and every House Democrat, voted for Representative Stephens, delivering him the role. This change in leadership will also likely impact who will be House committee chairs and who will be hearing our system's budget request. <u>To read more about the vote, click here.</u>

Representative Kevin McCarthy, minority leader from last Congress, was projected to face staunch opposition from his own party, despite no other Republican congressperson legitimately running right now.
