Governor's Budget: Earlier this week, Governor Mike DeWine delivered his State of the State address, outlining his funding and policy priorities for the next biennium and marking the unofficial kickoff of state budget season. Governor DeWine's speech focused heavily on programs and policies aimed at children and youth, including the development of a new cabinet agency, the Department of Children and Youth, as well as mental health, school safety and literacy and a quality initiative for Ohio's nursing facilities. Soon following the speech, the Office of Budget Management (OBM) released budget details, and the administration's proposed funding for their



policy priorities for the coming fiscal years. For Developmental Disability services, the Governor and his administration are proposing increases intended to raise the average wage of frontline staff to \$16/hr. Through a mix of General Revenue Funds (GRF) and dollars appropriated through ARPA, the proposal includes a 16.5% rate increase for residential waiver services, a 10% increase for day array services, including NMT, as well as a proposal to allow the ICF formula to run at a 6% increase each year, as well as a direct service add-on of 6.5%. There is still much work to do in the legislature to secure these proposed investments and achieve equitable increases across the services. That said, we are incredibly grateful to the Governor and his team, as well as the support of DODD, for these proposed increases and will continue to work to build on them through the process.
