Budget Season: Given that state budget season is underway and house committees are beginning to hold hearings on various facets of the Governor's proposed budget, it has been a busy week of outreach and advocacy with our executive and legislative partners. Pete and Christine both attended in-district meetings at member agencies with Representatives Ray and Plummer, as well as meetings with House Finance HHS Sub-Committee Chair, Rep. Carruthers and Senator Mark Romanchuk. We are so proud and appreciative of all of the outreach that OPRA members have done and continue to do with your local legislators. So far, there seems to be great support from the legislature in supporting I/DD services and that is because of the personal connections they have made with you. In addition to budget advocacy, we have also been a part of legislative meetings this week in support of an initiative to eliminate the age limit for the Medicaid Buy-in For Workers with Disabilities (MBIWD) program. Finally, we were able to meet with key leadership at DODD, including Director Hauck and Deputy Director Steve Beha, to discuss and work through several key issues we will be facing together over the next several months, including the budget, the Blueprint proposal, continued staffing challenges, proposed rule changes and much more.

<u>CMS Presentation:</u> This week, ANCOR held their ICF Community of Practice call. We were fortunate enough to have Don Howard from <u>CMS present information regarding citation and survey data</u> over the last 3 years. The presentation included data from the last couple years regarding top survey deficiencies including infection control. CMS did not provide any insight as to whether the vaccination mandate will end. The top 5 CMS Citations for 2022 were W454 and W455, W104, W249 and W331
