<u>Marijuana Law Update:</u> This week, the Ohio General Assembly spent most of the week debating changes of the recently passed Issue 2 (adult, recreational marijuana use law). Unlike Issue 1, the issue 2 was a citizen-led statutory change instead of a Constitutional change and is thus subject to change by the General Assembly. The Senate passed their version of changes, and we now wait for the House to either propose their own version, amend what the Senate passed, or concur with the Senate. <u>You can read about the changes here.</u>

<u>MUI Group:</u> This week OPRA participated in a meeting of the committee that is looking at rule revision for the MUI rule. We have a mix of folks from all areas of service including members of county boards, IA's, providers, individuals requiring services, as well as other entities looking at this rule. We are in the process of discussing issues regarding pending investigations as well as how consistent training methods across all counties can be applied. <u>HB 236:</u> This week, we attended an Interested Party meeting for HB 236, the 'Never Alone Act', which allows people in congregate care settings to designate someone to advocate on their behalf. <u>You can read the bill language here.</u> If you have thoughts, concerns, or comments on the legislation, please email them to <u>Christine</u>.

<u>Tele-health</u>: OPRA met with the group formed by the department to look at tele-health services being utilized as a waiver service. We have talked extensively about the importance of tele-health during the pandemic and further. Currently we are looking at the models of service in the states of Missouri and Pennsylvania to gather information as we move forward. We are on a very tight timeline with this as we want to be ready to file by April but also have the waiver amendment over to ODM by January.

<u>SB 143:</u> A few years ago, while Senator Romanchuk was in the House, he introduced a bill regarding the way residential and commercial electricity rate payers are billed and the various fees on the bill. It is a bit technical, but currently electricity providers have the ability to add whatever fees they want to bills and do not have to be transparent about the what the fees are. This bill requires more oversight of that process and make electricity providers justify their rates in front of the PUCO.
