

<u>PNM issues -</u> Yesterday, OPRA and other association representatives met with DODD and the Ohio Department of Medicaid to discuss the ongoing issues with the PNM. We did learn that the two departments meet daily in attempt to work through the support tickets of users struggling with the application. We will keep this dialogue open and hope to work collaboratively to address the many issues providers are experiencing. <u>OOD and Works 4 Me:</u> In addition to <u>the 'outreach funds' intended for providers who utilize 14c</u> <u>certificates to help communicate about the Works For Me Project</u>, OOD has just released a Provider Subject Matter Expert grant, which <u>can be found here</u>. This funding is intended for a provider who can support others help people attain competitive employment. A Family Engagement Coordinator will be released soon. <u>COVID Guidance:</u> During this week's national call with CMS we discussed the updated COVID guidance from the CDC and some of the confusion, especially for ICFs. <u>The CDC has now included</u> <u>COVID among their guidance for respiratory viruses</u> that also includes RSV and Flu. Importantly, the Covid guidance for Health Care settings has not changed. Similar to previous guidance, ICFs will have to determine which guidance to follow, based on factors such as the type of care you provide and medical complexity of those you serve.


