SOC Bill: On Wednesday, the US Senate passed the 'Recognizing the Role of Direct Support Professionals Act (S. 1332)', otherwise known as the 'SOC Code' bill. The bill urges the US Office of Management and Budget to create a Standard Occupational Classification code for DSPs, helping to strengthen and professionalize the direct support workforce. Per our partners at ANCOR; "The creation of a unique classification for DSPs is critical in enabling comprehensive and accurate data collection, allowing policymakers to better address the direct support workforce crisis. It is also important in helping states in setting reimbursement rates and stabilizing DSP wages." This bill has been a priority for ANCOR and OPRA has helped to advocate for it with Ohio's congressional delegation during our trips to Washington and in follow-up meetings. As the bill has passed the Senate, we have also had very positive meetings with US Representatives, including Rep. Marcy Kaptur's office in supporting the legislation in the House. <u>Federal Funding: Earlier today, Congress passed a \$1.2T spending package</u> in an effort to avoid a government shutdown. You can read highlights of what is in the <u>spending bill here.</u> Please reach out to <u>Christine</u> with any questions.

<u>Primaries:</u> Ohio held its primary elections on Tuesday, nominating Republican Bernie Moreno to challenge Democratic Senator Sherrod Brown for his US Senate seat. In state politics, we saw the primary unseat a handful of legislators, notably Rep. Sara Carruthers, who had chaired the Finance Subcommittee on Health and Human Services and helped advance the investments in DD services in last summer's state budget. <u>You can read the full results of Tuesday's primary here.</u>

<u>Employment Service RFP:</u> In this week's Memo Monday, DODD released an RFP for Employment Services, to coincide with the upcoming rule changes that will introduce outcome-based payments into our waiver Employment Services. Per the memo; "The awarded entity will partner with DODD to develop training content or e-learning courses related to employment services topics that will be uploaded onto DODD's MyLearning platform....An informational webinar will be offered on March 27, 2024, at 10 AM". <u>Click here to register for the webinar.</u>


