

Legislation to Watch

<u>HB 465:</u> This week Rep. Carruthers introduced <u>House Bill 465</u>. The bill would permit the installation of cameras in resident rooms of ICFs by the families of residents. The bill also creates a waiver service that permits monthly lump sum payments to parents of people on DODD-administered HCBS waivers.

<u>HB 265:</u> Next Tuesday at 1:30pm, the House Health Provider Services Committee will hear testimony from interested parties on <u>House Bill 265</u> (Never Alone Act). Those interested in submitting written testimony must do so by Monday at 1:30pm. Please let <u>Christine</u> know if you would like to provide testimony.

<u>SB 213:</u> Our partners at APSI hosted an information session on Senate Bill 213, legislation to recognize supported decision-making as an alternative to guardianship. The town hall was recorded and can be viewed <u>here</u>. Zoom Passcode: P@d#\$\$t1
