NASDDDS: Last week, Pete had the opportunity to attend the National Association of State Directors of Developmental Disability Services Federal Policy Symposium in Washington DC. The event featured presentations from CMS, The Administration for Community Living (ACL) and a state presentation from Hawaii. Most of the presentations and discussions were focused on the CMS

<u>MUI Rule:</u> During this week's many committee meetings, Rachel shared changes being proposed to the MUI rule. The proposed changes incorporate concepts of Just Culture, as well as redefining abuse categories, and specifying administrative procedures for various incidents. The proposed changes aim to align with the CMS Access Rule and improve the clarity and effectiveness of incident reporting and investigation processes. <u>You can download the presentation from the committees here.</u>We appreciate all of the member feedback and will continue to advocate and collaborate for the best rule and process possible. <u>Station MD Survey:</u> Our friends at Nisonger are encouraging those of you who have experience with StationMD to participate in a survey. They are trying to increase participation in their study from provider agency or ICF staff who have experience with StationMD (DSPs, nurses, Directors, etc.). Provider agency staff can take a <u>survey and participate in a focus group by clicking here.</u>

<u>OPRA Compensation Survey:</u> There is still time to complete OPRA's Compensation, Benefits and Turnover survey! Members who complete the survey receive a free copy of the survey report. Please reach out to <u>Christine</u> with any questions on the survey or survey process.

<u>OISP</u>: Reminder that for people receiving HCBS waiver services and in ICFs must have an OISP in the system by June 30th. This standard is being added to the compliance tools on July 1st, 2024. However, during the transition, the department and ODH have stated that there will be no citations issued related to plans not being in the online system until January 1, 2025. Please keep these dates in mind as you work through the process of changing over ISP's.

<u>Additional State Budget Survey Opportunity:</u> The Ability Center is conducting a study of how the budget increases are impacting providers and DSPs across the HCBS waiver programs. They are currently seeking providers to participate in focus groups about how providers are passing on the increases.
