<u>Multi-System Youth/Youth with Complex Needs:</u> As we have ongoing conversations with the Department, other members of the administration and partners, we'd love to get your input. <u>ANCOR ICF Call:</u> Yesterday OPRA participated in our national ANCOR ICF call. Thanks to some of the folks at ANCOR, we were able to locate the <u>CMS regulations around video cameras in ICF settings.</u> The regulations can be found in section 21.43 (page 115). It should be noted that these regulations focus only on cameras in common areas as it states that video cameras "may never be used in areas where there are the highest expectations of privacy". We will be having our national call with CMS in the next couple months, and will be seeking clarification on this regulation in light of the House Bill 465 legislation.

<u>State Plan Services:</u> We've recently been made aware of issues providers are running into around state plan services, specifically home health. The OISP is supposed to act as the "plan of care" for these services – and that's not being implemented or operationalized the same everywhere (or even understood). If you've had any issues with state plan home health, please reach out to <u>Teresa.</u>

<u>Learning Collaborative</u>: We're launching a Just Culture Learning Collaborative later this year. There will be an application to participate. The application will "go live" August 1.
