<u>Recreational Cannabis</u>: Recreational marijuana sales began this week, presenting a tricky situation, both as employers and as providers. After last November, OPRA hosted Vorys to do a presentation on employer obligations under the new laws; <u>you can view the presentation and some other resources</u> <u>here.</u> DODD has also previously published <u>guidance that can be found here</u>. As your agencies sort the various complex issues related to the sale of recreational marijuana, send these scenarios to <u>Christine</u>. We will be compiling these examples for further guidance from either DODD or Vorys.

<u>ICF Rates:</u> Yesterday we met with Plante Moran as we are taking a deep dive into the ICF cost report data. Given the wage increases, this has been a critical year for ICFs. We will be hosting Denise Leonard and TJ Ely from Plante Moran at our next ICF committee meeting on August 21st. Denise and TJ will present some of their information as well as hit on some recommendations for ICF providers to implement. Both our ICF and RW committees will meet on 8/21.
