<u>Simulated Patient Opportunity</u>: Our friends at the Nisonger Center reached out to share this opportunity for people with disabilities in the Franklin County area; "reaching out to invite you all to participate in the next FOSCE training for medical students. This is one of their Formative Observed Simulated Clinical Experiences (FOSCE), which helps them prepare to talk with patients with disabilities as a future doctor. You would pretend to be a patient so they can practice their interview skills. There is not physical exam involved, they just take your history.
