<u>Provider Cert Rules:</u> This week we provided feedback on both the Agency Provider Certification and the Licensed Facility Administration rules. We are supportive of DODD's proposal to establish a 'Direct Support Assistant' role for staff who are 16/17 years old, who can provide services in a limited capacity. DODD is also proposing to remove the requirement for DSPs to hold a High School or equivalent degree. These changes make permanent the waiver that has been in place for the past few years. We also proposed that DODD allow more flexibility in training requirements and to move away from the 'Director of Operations' designation for an agency lead.

<u>OOD Fee Schedule:</u> OOD sent a message this week that their fee schedule proposal has cleared the JCARR (Joint Committee on Agency Rule Review) process, making it on track for implementation October 1st, as planned.

Non-Compete Ban Blocked: Earlier this week, the U.S. District Court for the Northern District of Texas struck down the FTC's non-compete ban, permanently and nationally. According to the court, the FTC "exceeded its statutory authority in implementing the rule, and the rule is arbitrary and capricious." Click here to read more from our partners at Vorys.
