Policy Summit & Hill Day: The OPRA team was able to join several of our members in Washington DC this week for ANCOR's annual policy event. After a great day of learning from prominent policymakers, we hit the hill for several visits with US legislators and/or their offices. We had the opportunity to meet with the offices of Sens. JD Vance and Sherrod Brown, Reps Jim Jordan, Marcy Kaptur, Joyce Beatty, Robert Latta, Troy Balderson, Shontel Brown, Emilia Sykes, Marcy Kaptur and more! Our teams advocated for a passage of the DSP SOC Code bill, as well as additional resources for Medicaid-funded services.

<u>Adult Use Cannabis FAQ:</u> We anticipate guidance from Vorys on recreational marijuana and frequently asked questions for providers and employers next week. If you have any questions you would like included, please send them to <u>Christine</u>.

<u>EVV:</u> Christine is interested in hearing from the field about your experience using EVV, particularly if you are using the state system. We have heard various issues since changes implemented in the summer and are trying to get a better grasp on the issues. Please send your thoughts to <u>Christine</u>.

<u>COVID Tests</u>: The federal government is once again providing free COVID-19 tests to households this year. Every US household is eligible for up to 4 tests. The portal to order tests opened this past Thursday. Visit <u>COVIDTests.gov</u> to have four test kits sent to your home for free. Additionally, there are tests available that are more accessible for people with disabilities (while supplies last). To order the accessible tests, there is a separate page, which can <u>be found here</u>. Tests distributed are also able to detect the dominant variants that are circulating, including the subvariant KP.3.1.1 and KP.3.

<u>Coalition Survey:</u> The DD Budget Coalition is again seeking input from agency providers on how the state's most recent rate increases are impacting services on the ground. The Coalition put together the next edition of our periodic survey to gather information on agency providers' experiences. This survey will remain open until September 30th, 2024. These surveys provide important data that the budget coalition can use to show the efficacy of last budget's rate increases and to continue to advocate for continued support and resources.
