<u>Election Update:</u> Christine and Pete provided an update on the results of the election and what it could mean for providers. <u>You can view the PowerPoint here</u>. Key Ohio election results are outlined below. Please contact <u>Christine</u> with any questions.

US House of Representatives:

- Toss-up seats- Reps. Sykes and Landsman held on to seats.
- Rep. Kaptur's district still counting, but Kaptur leads.

US Senate:

• Incumbent Senator Sherrod Brown lost his re-election bid to political newcomer Bernie Moreno.

President-elect Trump and Senator JD Vance will take office in January:

- Senator Vance will vacate his Senate role
- Governor DeWine will select Senator Vance's replacement

Ohio House:

- Democrats flipped 2 seats
- In District 10, Democratic Councilman Mark Sigirst defeated Republican Brian Garvine. In District 11, Republican Senator Stephanie Kunze lost to Democratic challenger Crystal Lett.

Ohio Senate:

- No major surprises or upsets
- Democrats now have 9 members
- Anticipate a Senate President McColley; Finance Chair Cirino

All County Board levies on the ballot passed: Congrats!

<u>MUI Rule:</u> The <u>proposed MUI RULE</u> is ready to be moved on to clearance. Please note that the terminology of "Accidental or Suspicious Death" has been removed from the rule and replaced with "Unexpected or Unanticipated Death". OPRA is very pleased with this change as it provides for more consistency with the CMS Access Rule while removing any negative connotation that could be implied with the term 'suspicious'. Additionally, there have been some verbiage changes to the Unanticipated Hospitalization section to provide for more clarity. Although the rule is being submitted for clearance, there will still be a time to submit official comment on the rule. If you would like to provide official comments to the rule, please email <u>Rachel</u>.

<u>Committee:</u> Thank you to everyone who attended and participated in yesterday's Day and Employment service committee meeting. In the meeting we discussed the development of 2 subcommittees; a group for Project Search Providers to discuss challenges and best practices and a 'Subject Matter Expert' group of members who have transitioned from 14c services.
