<u>MUI:</u> The <u>MUI Rule has officially been filed.</u> Please note that the Public Hearing will be held on Thursday February 13th at 10:00am in the Rhodes Tower. Persons unable to attend the hearing may still submit written testimony. The department is hopeful that the rule will be enacted on or around March 23, 2025. Please reach out to <u>Rachel</u> if you would like to provide public testimony or if there are any questions around the rule.

<u>Training Meeting:</u> On January 13th and 14th OPRA will be hosting a member discussion regarding training needs and how OPRA can better provide valuable training resources. You can register for those discussions <u>here for the 13th</u> and <u>here for the 14th</u>.

<u>OOD Updates:</u> Our partners at OOD have released this year's Summer Youth Work Experience On-Demand training. There are two training videos; the annual training and the 2025 Safe & Sound Update training. Unlike in previous years, these trainings are located in Ohio Learning and at least one qualified staff must complete the trainings through that platform. "This year, the training is focused on the 2025 service changes and offers key service and billing reminders." Additionally, OOD is launching a ""Community & Workplace Inclusion" Webinar Series to Support Ohioans with Disabilities." The series begins January 15th, with a session on 'Accessible Communications' and will continue with monthly sessions through November. <u>To learn more, click here.</u> Please reach out to Scott with any questions or feedback.

<u>Telehealth Assessment:</u> Station MD is now certified with the health care assessment service as officially approved by CMS. It can now be added to any waiver recipients ISP.

<u>ICF OISP Training:</u> Milestones is providing OISP assessment training for QIDP's. You can now <u>register for the in-person trainings here</u>. Trainings will be 9:30am - 4:30pm with a 1 hour lunch at 12:30 and will be conducted in each region of the state.

Pre-voc and Employment Services: Thank you to everyone who participated in our committee discussions on the proposed employment waiver services and changes. You can review the rule proposals here. We are asking members to provide feedback to Scott by January 15th. As discussed this week, there is still some uncertainty on the rate appendix of the Group Employment Rule proposal. At this point, we are asking members to consider and provide feedback on the proposals as they are currently drafted, understanding there may be some revisions before the proposals are officially filed or moved forward. We would especially ask members to consider the impact of the elimination of the Community Voc Hab service for the Group Career Exploration service proposed (as part of the Career Planning rule/service), as well as proposed reduction in group size for GES and the 'tier' definitions under BEST as they pertain to the 'places on the path'. We do expect to see revisions to these proposals based on our and other stakeholder feedback. Please reach out to Scott with any questions and/or feedback on the rules.
