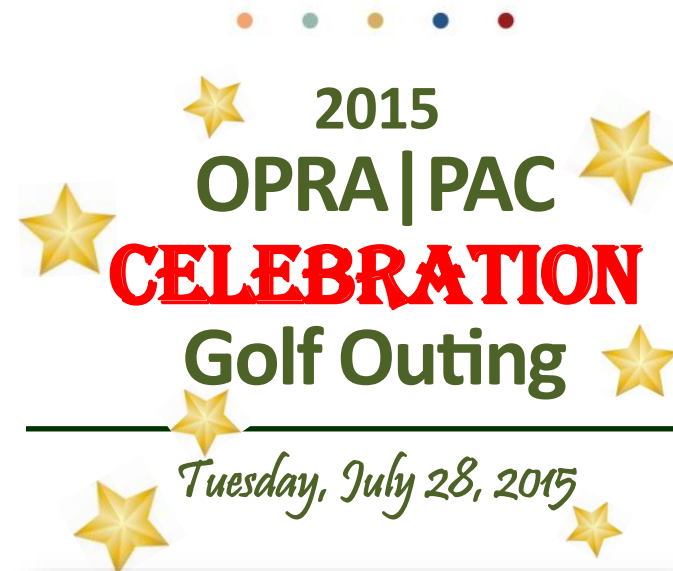

In 1993, Pete's son, P.B. Dye, finished the job by adding a second nine holes. Urbana Country Club is home to one of the finest and most beautiful rolling-hill, 18-hole golf courses in the State of Ohio.

Urbana Country Club requires the use of **soft spikes**, as well as **proper golf attire**. Players needing soft spikes installed on their shoes should arrive before 8:30 a.m. The spike fee is \$8.00/pair.
