<u>Acting Director:</u> Earlier this week, Lyndsay Nash was named as Acting Director following Director Kim Hauck's retirement today. Lyndsay currently serves as DODD's Assistant Director. DODD's announcememnt reads " She will serve in this acting position as the formal appointment process for the next Director moves forward. All DODD programs and services will continue without interruption. The Governor's office and DODD leadership remain aligned in our mission to support Ohioans with developmental disabilities." We look forward to working with Lyndsay until a 'permanent' director is named.

<u>HB 96 (State Operating Budget):</u> After the release of the conference committee's version of 96, the Ohio House and Senate passed the state operating budget bill. The bill passed the House by a vote of 59 to 38 and the Senate by a vote of 23 to 10. Unlike in previous budgets, not a single Democrat in either chamber voted in favor for the bill. Major DODD provisions in the final bill include;

- Maintain last budget's investment in HCBS waivers and ICFs
- Maintain Governor's proposed ICF PWD through the next fiscal year
- REMOVES the DD system sustainability and reform task force amendment
- Uses the House-passed language to increase the ICF personal needs allowance to \$75/individual and \$150/married couple
- Require that DODD submit their budget request for into separate line items for ICF and HCBS services
 - Currently, funding for both ICF and HCBS waiver services are combined into one line item in DODD's budget

Christine sent an email earlier in the week that also included the latest provisions for the Ohio Department of Medicaid (ODM) and OOD. Once we have Governor DeWine's signature and vetoes, we will be hosting a longer presentation on the final version and all of the bill's provisions.

<u>BEST/GES:</u> Over the weekend, Director Hauck shared an email with representatives from the Blueprint Committee, including draft rules for Group Employment Supports, BEST, and Career Planning. While DODD adopted much of our latest feedback into these drafts, we still have a couple major items of concern. We will continue discussions with the membership as to the best path forward and approach to advocacy as DODD prepares to send these rules for clearance and public comment for an implementation date of 7/1/26. The rule drafts can be found at <u>the OPRA website here</u>. <u>MUI Training:</u> Last reminder, all DD personnel must be trained on the new MUI rule by 7/1/25. DODD will be uploading MUI training to the My Learning website on July 7/1/25. Reach out to <u>Rachel</u> with any questions.

<u>Wage Survey:</u> Thank you to everyone who completed their DSP Compensation survey by the deadline this week of 6/25. We know this is a time-consuming process, but is integral in maintaining and advocating for DD services and viable reimbursement rates.
