5124.41 of the Revised Code and subject to division (C) of this	29
section, the Department of Developmental Disabilities shall	30
disregard, for the purpose of the Medicaid payment rates for	31
ICF/IID services provided during fiscal year 2017, the results of	32
an exception review conducted under section 5124.193 of the	33
Revised Code during calendar year 2015 if the results are based on	34
a change the Department made to either of the following:	35
