## **Types of Services Available**

#### Assessment

Assessment is completed by a licensed mental health clinician to assess for the need for further services. From the assessment, the clinician will develop recommendations and a treatment plan to guide future services.

### **Behavior Management**

Staff can develop behavior plans to provide support to caregivers in the home, school, or workshop setting.

# Counseling

Counseling can be provided to individuals and their family members.

Mental Health Case Management (CPST) Staff are able to provide specific skill building and education, advocacy and coordination of services and help eliminate barriers to effective mental health treatment. Staff also conduct Life Coaching groups with individuals employed at Quest for Independence.

# Psychiatric Services

Medication management can be provided internally or coordinated with external psychiatrist

# How do you pay for it?

We accept Medicaid and are also able to bill private insurances as an out-of-network provider. Clients with Medicaid Managed Care programs are typically eligible under Medicaid even if not through the managed care program. ViaQuest Clinical Services is approved as an I/O waiver provider for Social Work Services.

For those who do not wish to use their insurance or have a high deductible, we offer a sliding fee scale based on family income.

#### **Accreditations**

ViaQuest Clinical Services is accredited by CARF (Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities) and certified by the Ohio Department of Mental Health, Ohio Department of Alcohol and Drug Addiction Services, and The Ohio Rehabilitation Services Commission.
