L. Eugene Arnold, MD, MEd, is a board certified child psychiatrist and Professor Emeritus at the OSU College of Medicine. He attended The Ohio State University for medical school, and completed residencies in psychiatry and child psychiatry at Johns Hopkins University. Dr. Arnold has been on faculty at Ohio State since 1970, and has also served as a scientific advisor for the National Institute of Mental Health. Dr. Arnold has co-authored more than 200 scientific papers, as well as nine books and numerous book chapters. Dr. Arnold's research focuses on new drug development and alternative and complementary treatments for autism and ADHD. His research includes aromatic essential oil therapy for autism spectrum disorder, omega-3 fatty acids for mood disorders, neurofeedback for ADHD, nutrition and mental health, and clinical trials.
